- 1 Senate Square The Cathedral is an iconic landmark. Built during the Russian rule as a tribute to Czar Nicholas. Open from 9:30, times vary. Free Entrance. Take a break in one of the many cozy cafes in the area and stroll for the handicrafts and Souvenirs.
- 2 Katajanokka District historic Katajanokka district and visit Uspenski Cathedral. Discover Helsinki from top of Skywheel Helsinki. Experience Helsinki's sights and attractions in the amazing multimedia show at Flying Cinema Tour of Helsinki.
- 3 Havis Amanda Famous female statue sculpted in 1908. Walk the Old Market Hill. Take the Royal Line Original Helsinki Sightseeing Cruise from Market Square (19€).
- 4 Olympic Terminal/Naamattoman Museum Formerly the Stockholm - terminal built for the 1952 Olympics. Museum dedicated to Gustaf Mannerheim, Marshal of Finland.
- 5 Kaivopuisto Park Take a stroll up to the Observatory Hill and enjoy the spectacular sea view.
- 6 Compass Square stroll along the beautiful waterfront of Eira and enjoy a refreshing ice cream by the seaside.
- 7 Eira Beautiful neighborhood with Jugend style houses and embassies. Visit popular and elegant Cafe Central.
- 8 Helsingin Risteilyterminali A docking point for international cruise ships. Operated in connection with specific cruise ships.
- 9 Helsingin Risteilyterminali Offers Cafes, Restaurants, Terraces, and traditional Finnish Sauna. Lively with unique architecture.
- 10 Helsinki Cruise Terminal Another docking point for international cruise ships. Operated in connection with specific cruise ships.
- 11 Hietalahti Flea Market/Market Hall Charming flea market at the Hietalahti Market Square and traditional covered food market. Join the Osmuus Murder Walk by Green Cap Tours to hear about the most intriguing homicides in Helsinki. In June-July/August on Wednesdays, Fridays and Saturdays at 14:00 from City Tour bus stop 11.
- 12 Soukka The Soukka is known for its Cafes and Art Galleries. Visit Teekkariälyt street for unique and exclusive shopping, for exclusive jewelry visit Soukka Diamond.
- 13 Kumpuliiton Keskus Visit the National Museum at Tennispalatsi (Tennis Palace), Kumpuliiton Shopping Centre and National History Museum.
- 14 Rauhankirkko Discover the most unique church in Finland, built into the bedrock. Explore the impressive exterior. Open from 10:00, times vary. Entrance fee 3€.
- 15 Sibelius Monument An impressive stainless steel monument dedicated to the famous Finnish composer Jean Sibelius. Free entrance. Enjoy a cup of coffee with a delicious cinnamon bun in the quaint Cafe Regatta by the seaside.
- 16 Toivakka district has many trendy cafes, well-reviewed restaurants and small shops, and is full of Nordic design stores. Explore Helsinki's past at the Tram Museum. Free entrance.
- 17 Olympic Stadium Take a picture of the Olympic Stadium and its tower. The Stadium is closed for renovations until 2019.
- 18 SeaLife Uusimaa Short walk to Sea Life Helsinki and Uusimaa Amusement Park. Take a stroll along the shores of Toivakka Bay and visit Helsinki City Botanic Garden.
- 19 Parliament/National Museum The Parliament of Finland. Explore the history of Finland at the National Museum. Visit the Helsinki Music Centre.
- 20 City Centre/Laapio A good spot for shopping - Forum Shopping Centre and Mieskieli clothing company's Big Top Store. Visit Hard Rock Cafe Helsinki.
- 21 Swedish Theatre Visit Stockmann Department Store and shop for Finnish Design along the Esplanade shopping street. Short walking distance to Design Museum Helsinki.
- 22 Esplanade Park/Market Square stroll along historical Esplanade and take the Original Helsinki Sightseeing Cruise from Market Square to see the beautiful archipelago (19€).
